There are already a number of suggestions from those who participated in March, and from the follow up session on April 13th, including:

1. Repeat the Week of Guided Prayer as an annual Parish retreat (positive news! Sr Eibhlis will send us a team next year at the beginning of Lent - from Sunday 23rd February to Saturday 1st March 2020).

- 2. Organise monthly Lectio Divina meetings to pray with the scriptures of the following Sunday Mass.
- 3. Organise monthly individual prayer guidance as in the Week of Guided Prayer.
- 4. Set up Eucharistic Adoration monthly or weekly, if enough people sign up to do one hour (currently in Kilmacanogue 1st Wednesday of the month, 7-8pm)
 - $5.\ Organise\ prayer\ gatherings\ attractive\ to\ young\ people,\ e.g.\ Taize-style.$ 6. Offer a traditional parish retreat with Masses and talks. Any further suggestions, ideas, or offers of help are very welcome.
